Table 4 represents bachelor degrees awarded to all students in the alliance by targeted STEM, total STEM and total Non-STEM. The table shows that three institutions contributed 71% of bachelor degrees awarded to targeted STEM students in the alliance. That is, Marquette University awarded 28 degrees (or 16.4% of the total); UW-Milwaukee awarded 53 degrees (or 31% of the total); and UW-Madison awarded 41 degrees (or 24% of the total). However, Lawrence University, Marquette University, UW-Madison, UW-Platteville, UW-River Falls and UW-Stevens Point each awarded 20% or more of their degrees in STEM fields. At UW-Platteville, 47.2% of all degrees were awarded to STEM students. These differences underscore the benefit of having an alliance of different types of schools, as there is potential varies at each of the institutions.
